Admission Notification for 4-Year B. Tech. Programme

Applications on prescribed form are invited for admission to 4-year B. Tech. programme for the academic session 2010 in the following disciplines:

1. Computer Science and Engineering at University of Kashmir North Campus, Delina, Baramulla, and
2. Electronics and Communication Engineering at the Department of Electronics and Instrumentation Technology, University of Kashmir Main Campus, Hazratbal, Srinagar.

Eligibility:

The candidates seeking admission to the said programmes must fulfill the following eligibility conditions.

- **Should have passed Higher Secondary part II (10+2) from J & K Board of School Education or any other recognized Board with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) subjects, having at least 50% marks in aggregate in case of open category and “Persons from outside the state, including foreign nationals” and 45% marks for other Reserved categories.**
- **Should be permanent resident of J & K State, except in case of reserved category “Persons from outside the state, including foreign nationals”**
- **Should be 17 years old on or before January 01, 2010.**

Issuance of Application Form:

The Prospectus along with Application form will be available from **26th July, 2010** against the Cash payment of **Rs.300/=** from the following offices:

- Sale Counter, University of Kashmir near Maulana Rumi Gate, Hazratbal, Srinagar;
- University of Kashmir, North Campus, Delina, Baramulla, Kashmir;
- University of Kashmir, South Campus, Fatehgarh, Anantnag;
- University of Kashmir, Sub-Office, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu;
- J & K Bank Leh/Kargil Branch (Bank shall charge **Rs. 15/-** as handling charges per Prospectus from the candidates).

The prospectus and application form can also be down-loaded from the University website, 'www.kashmiruniversity.net' or 'www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in'. With each application form, bearing a distinct Serial Number, is appended a fee pay-in-slip which also bears the same Serial Number as that of Application Form.

Submission of Application Form:

1. A candidate is required to deposit the Entrance Test fee of **Rs. 225/-** through the Pay-in-Slip attached with the Application Form (and bearing the same Serial No. as on the Application

Form) at any branch of the J&K Bank Ltd. having “Finacle Enabled Banking” facility. Xeroxed copy of the Application Form will not be accepted as it would not carry any distinct Serial No. and as such candidates are advised to fill in the Application Form and Pay-in-Slip very carefully, without overwriting and mutilation.

2. In case the candidate is submitting a downloaded Application Form, he/she shall add the cost of the Prospectus (**i.e. Rs. 300/-**) to the total Entrance Fee to be deposited through the Pay-in-Slip.
3. No Application Form shall be accepted unless it is appended with the attested copies of the following Certificates:
 - a. Marks Certificates of the qualifying examination;
 - b. Reserved Category Certificate (if applicable) signed by the Competent Authority in respect of candidates seeking admission under Reserved Categories. The University shall not entertain the Plea “**Certificate Under Process**”.
 - c. State Subject Certificate (if it is not available, a residence Certificate signed by a Gazetted Officer should be appended).
 - d. Date of birth certificate/Matriculation certificate.
4. The Application complete in all respects must be submitted by or before **7th of August, 2010 up to 4.30pm**, at any of the following offices against receipt on the back side of the Depositors copy of the Pay-in-slip.
 - Office of the Head, Dept. of Electronics & Instrumentation Technology, University of Kashmir, Main Campus, Hazratbal.
 - Office of the Director, North Campus, University of Kashmir, Delina, Baramulla, Kashmir.
 - Office of the Director, South Campus, University of Kashmir, Anantnag, Kashmir.
 - University of Kashmir, Sub-Office, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu.

Mode of Selection:

Candidates shall be admitted to the Programme on the basis of merit obtained in the Entrance Test to be conducted by the University for the purpose (reduced to the base of 60) combined with the marks obtained in PCM of the qualifying examination (reduced to the base of 40). The overall merit on which the candidates are selected for the Programme shall be determined out of **100 (= 60 + 40)** marks.

Entrance Test:

The eligible candidates shall have to appear in the Entrance Test at their own expenses at the University specified centers. Notification regarding the date of conduct of Test and Allotment of Examination Centre will be issued by the University separately.
