Admission Notification

2-Year M.Pharm.2011-2012

On- Line Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to 2-Year M.Pharm. Programme for the academic session 2011 at Main Campus, University of Kashmir, Hazratbal, Srinagar.

Eligibility:

The candidates must fulfill the following eligibility conditions.

- **Should have passed Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) from the University of Kashmir or any other Institute recognized by UGC/ AICTE with at least 55% marks in aggregate for Open merit and 45% marks for reserved category.**
- **GPAT qualified candidate will be given preference in admission and they shall be exempted from appearing in the entrance test.**
- **The candidate should be state subject of the Jammu and Kashmir.**

Issuance of Application Form:

The Prospectus will be available from Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Kashmir, Hazratbal, Srinagar from 07-12-2011 against the cash payment of **Rs. 350/=**.

Submission of On-line Application Form:

The applicants are advised to peruse the “*M.Pharm. Prospectus 2011*” thoroughly and then follow the below given steps for submitting their application forms.

- The candidates shall access official website of the University, “www.kashmiruniversity.net/ www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in” and click on “*Application Form for 2-Year M.Pharm. Programme*”.
- Enter the Prospectus No. & Prospectus Receipt No., the Application Form will be displayed, which is to be filled by the candidate;
- Once the submitted Application Form is accepted, a distinct ‘Form Number’ will be displayed on the monitor, which needs to be noted by the candidates for use in future;
- After the completion of the acceptance of the application the candidates shall open their Application Form by entering the Form number and Date of Birth (DOB) so as to download the auto-generated Application Form and Pay-in-Slip bearing the Serial Number as reflected on the web generated Application Form;
- The Pay-in-Slip provided with the downloaded Application Form and bearing the same serial number as on the main application form should be used for depositing the requisite Entrance Fee of **Rs. 250/-** at any branch of the J&K Bank Ltd;
- The print out (hard copy) need not to be submitted but the particulars mentioned by the candidate should be checked carefully and if any mistake occurs during On-Line submission in such case the candidate should contact the office of the Dean Academic Affairs, University of Kashmir.
- **The last date for submission of On-Line Application Forms is 15.12.2011;**

- The admit cards can be downloaded from the official website 'www.kashmiruniversity.net/ www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in' only after reconciliation of the candidates fee is made with the J&K Bank Ltd;
- Status of the admit card can be checked from the official website of the University by entering the Form Number and Date of Birth;
- The eligible candidates shall have to appear in the Entrance Test at their own expenses at the University specified centers.

Mode of Selection:

Candidates shall be admitted to various branches of M.Pharm. on the basis of merit prepared in accordance with VALID GPAT percentile score. The merit of NON-GPAT candidate shall be determined as under:

- i) Weightage for entrance test examination ----- 60%
- ii) Weightage for academic merit in B.Pharm. ----- 40%

Further the admission of NON-GPAT candidates to a particular specialization will depend on the availability of seats in the respective specialization after filling up of the seats by the GPAT qualified candidates. **The syllabus for the Entrance Test shall be strictly based on B.Pharm. syllabus of this University.**

Entrance Test:

The eligible candidates shall have to appear in the Entrance Test at their own expenses at the University specified centers. Notification regarding the date of conduct of Test and Centre notice will be issued by the University separately.

Note: Notification for Self Financing Seats Category shall be issued separately.
