Besides research articles, *ESI* has separate sections devoted to creative writing, translation, especially of Kashmiri texts into English and book reviews.

Handwritten manuscripts will not be entertained. All contributions will be got evaluated by some eminent scholars in the field and only those papers will be published which receive positive reports. Contributions must have a certificate attached that the article has not been submitted/accepted for publication in any other journal in India and/or abroad.

ESI follows the latest MLA style-sheet in that the references to authors/works are given in parentheses within the body of the text and then arranged alphabetically at the end of the paper under 'References'. Footnotes and/or endnotes should not be used. For a better understanding of this style the latest issue of the journal may be consulted.
