

NOTIFICATION

In supersession to this office notifications dated 09-12-2013 & 03-06-2014, it is notified for the information of all the concerned that on the recommendations of the committee constituted for the purpose, the Vice-Chancellor has authorized modification of Single Paper Scheme as under:-

1. Single paper scheme shall be applicable to B.A, B.Sc., B.Com, BBA, BCA, MCMP, B.Com (Hons), B.A (English Hons) courses;
2. Each subject shall have internal as well as external components of examinations;
3. The question paper for the external component of examination shall be of three hours duration replacing the existing 2 ½ hours duration.

Continuous Assessment:-

1. Internal examination shall be read as Continuous Assessment having two components viz a) Mid-term test and b) Attendance. Both the components shall be compulsory;
2. The students failing in Continuous Assessment in any subject/s shall not be allowed to sit in the theory examination in that particular subject/s;
3. In case of Lab oriented subjects excluding BBA/BCA/B.Com Hons, candidates as would have passed in three subjects in continuous assessment shall be eligible to appear in the annual theory examination in the respective qualifying subjects, other candidates shall complete requirements (Midterm and attendance) during next session;
4. In case of non-lab oriented courses/subjects including BA English Hons, candidates who have passed in three subjects in continuous assessment shall be eligible to appear in the respective qualifying subjects as regular candidates or as private candidates in all the four subjects; further, candidates failing in more than one subject in continuous assessment shall be eligible to appear in all the four subjects as fresh private candidates only;
5. In case of BBA/BCA/B.Com Hons, candidates failing in not more than two subjects in continuous assessment shall be eligible to appear in the annual theory examination in the respective qualifying subjects. The paper wise breakup of marks in case of BBA/BCA/B.Com(Honors)/B.A English (Honors) first year is given in annexure;
6. Within the group of Humanities and Commerce, if a student has opted for a Lab oriented subject viz Geography, Psychology, Indian music, Travel and tourism etc. and fails to qualify Continuous Assessment in more than one subject will be allowed to change his status from regular to private mode only if he/she opts for subject combination having no Lab Oriented course/subject;
7. The distribution of marks for Mid-term and Attendance is reflected in the table as under:-

8. Shortage of attendance in case it is 10% or less than 10% will be condoned by the Vice Chancellor of the University and the Principal of the College (5% each). If after condonation, the Attendance of the student works out to 75% to 79.99%, the student will get 2 marks or 4 marks in Attendance depending upon whether the Midterm carries 20 marks or 40 marks;
9. In case the candidate falls short of attendance even at the end of the academic session, the college will make all efforts to arrange extra/special classes next year in order to allow such candidates to make up their attendance.
10. Where the candidate has failed in midterm test, he/she shall have to qualify the same next year before the commencement of theory examination of backlog/failure candidates in order to become eligible to appear in the said examination. The submission of midterm awards for such candidates will be against the fresh examination Roll numbers to be allotted by the University of Kashmir;
11. The candidate who does not fulfill the requirement of attendance before midterm test shall be allowed to appear in the Midterm test on his/her own risk and responsibility subject to the condition that he/she completes the requirement of mandatory attendance before the commencement of the theory examination. Candidate will submit an affidavit in this regard in his/her respective college. In case a candidate is not able to complete the required attendance he/she will not be allowed to appear in the examination but his/her midterm marks will carry out next if the candidate fails to appear in the annual examination.
12. At least two units shall be covered in each subject for midterm test. Midterm test shall be conducted during July-August each year. Award rolls against the Examination Roll number shall be submitted to the University of Kashmir at least 15 days before commencement of the external theory examination;
13. The answer scripts of mid-term test and attendance register shall be preserved upto one year by the college. These will be subject to an inspection by the Principal of the College/University inspection team or Controller of Examinations;

External examination

1. For external theory examination the syllabus of each subject shall consist of five units;
2. Examination will be conducted by the Controller of Examinations of University of Kashmir at the end of academic session;
3. There will be two types of questions in the question paper i.e medium and long answer type questions;
4. There will be five medium type questions with equal weightage- one question with internal choice from each unit. All the five questions will be compulsory;
5. There shall be five long answer type questions with equal weightage one from each unit; and the student will be required to attempt any three questions;

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The distribution of marks is reflected in the table as under:-

6. Pass percentage shall remain unchanged i.e 36%;
7. Re-evaluation scheme as provided under the existing statutes shall remain unchanged. Eligibility shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in External Theory examination. Continuous Assessment shall not be subject to any re-evaluation;
8. The single paper scheme in no way shall affect the present eligibility norms for promotion to the next Higher class;

Private candidates

Private candidates shall be subject to same external examination pattern as is applicable to the candidates in regular mode. There won't be any Continuous Assessment for the Private candidates. The marks of the candidates will be raised strictly in proportion to the percentage of marks obtained in the External examination.
