

## **20 KU trained AIEEE aspirants qualify**

### **Results encouraging: Director DLL**

**Srinagar, June 1:** All India Engineering Entrance Examination (AIEEE) coaching organized by Directorate of Lifelong Learning, University of Kashmir fetched results with 20 students qualifying the examination.
