

KU VC visits Girls Hostels

Interacts with borders, calls for up-gradation of facilities

Srinagar, July 2: The Kashmir University vice-chancellor, Prof Riyaz Punjabi, Thursday visited the Girls Hostels of the University to take a stock of the facilities available there.

Prof Punjabi interacted with the boarders for nearly two hours. He took stock of the ongoing construction works in the Hostels.

Prof Punjabi issued on the spot instructions to officials asking them to upgrade the Browsing Centres, Information Technology units and Reading Rooms of the Hostels.

The VC also gave instructions to make available the services of a female engineer in the Girls Hostels to facilitate the regular monitoring and upkeep of the infrastructure.

Prof Punjabi was accompanied by the KU Registrar Prof S Fayyaz Ahmad, Provost, Prof Naseem A Shah, Wardens and other officials of the University. Besides providing free medical supplies and healthcare facilities, Prof Punjabi directed the medical staff of the university to keep round the clock services available to the students.

Earlier Prof Naseem A Shah briefed Prof Punjabi about various facilities for borders. Prof Shah also talked about the healthcare, sports and other facilities available to borders.

Later the VC interacted with the boarders on a number of issues of academic importance. He keenly listened to the borders and issued on spot instructions to the officers concerned for the speedy redress of the grievances.
