The University of Jammu and Kashmir was founded in the year 1948. In the year 1969 it was bifurcated into two full-fledged Universities - University of Kashmir at Srinagar and University of Jammu at Jammu. - For candidates falling under the Reserved Categories namely (i) "Persons from outside the Kashmir Division", (ii) "Foreign Nationals", (iii) "NRI/NRI sponsored" and (iv) "Children of Permanent Employees (serving/retired) of the University of Kashmir", the minimum eligibility shall be the same as that for the open merit category in all Programmes/Courses offered.
- Candidates possessing postgraduate degree/s are eligible to seek admission in another postgraduate programme or in a Diploma/Certificate course, if they fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down for admission; however, no benefit of reserved category can be granted, if already availed, in the identical programme/course.
- A candidate can simultaneously pursue a full-time PG Programme and one PG Programme (through Distance Mode) or part-time (Morning/Evening) Certificate Courses.



Section III – Admission Procedure

[including Application, Entrance, Eligibility, Merit, Seat Reservation, Selection, Fee Structure etc.]

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(I) Applications [Applying Provisionally for Admission - Appeared or Result awaited Category]

Candidates (from Kashmir Division or having qualified from Universities or Boards or Institutes of Kashmir Division) having passed the qualifying examination are eligible; furthermore, candidates who have appeared or are appearing in the qualifying examination can also apply provisionally on their own risk and responsibility, subject to fulfilling all eligibility conditions including acquiring minimum required percentage upto **18th May 2026 (for Courses/Programmes based on 12th)** and **28th July 2026 (for Programmes based on Graduation)**. If a candidate fails to fulfil eligibility upto last date fixed for the purpose, he/she shall not figure in the Merit List, even if having appeared in the Entrance Test; however, if any such candidate becomes eligible during the admission process, he/she shall be considered for admission as per merit if seats are available in the relevant Course/Programme after all the eligible candidates have been exhausted. The candidates shall be personally reasonable to inform about the declaration of the qualifying examination within stipulated date as mentioned above and for any kind of delay on the part of candidates, the University shall not be responsible for any consequence;

(II) PURSUING OF DUAL DEGREE

Candidates can pursue two academic programmes simultaneously *i.e.*, one regular and the other through Distance/Open/Online Mode in accordance with the UGC regulations dated 13th April, 2022.

(III) Procedure for submission of On-Line Application Forms:

The candidates shall follow the below steps to fill On-Line Application Form

Step-1:

Visit <http://www.kashmiruniversity.net> or www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in and click on Link **Admissions**. Read Important Instructions for Registration and Submission of Form carefully before proceeding further.

Step-2:

Candidate needs to register himself/herself before submitting the Online Application Form. For Registration with the System Click on the "Register as Student". Remember, the Username and Password for future reference.

Step-3:

After successful Registration, login into the system for submitting On-line Application Form. Enter your "Registration No." and Click "Next".

**Step-4:**

Enter the required details and Upload your latest passport size Photograph and click "Next".

Step-5:

Select the desired Preferences (After last date the Preference of Campus/College selected will not be updated/changed). Click "Next".

Step-6:

If there is any variation click on "Previous" button, make necessary corrections and then Click "Submit". Get a printout of the Form and note the Form No. for future reference.

Step-7:

Deposit the non-refundable "Application Fee of Rs. 400/- (including Rs. 150/- as IT Fee) and Entrance Test fee of Rs. 500/-" i.e., Rs. 900/- for one Programme and Rs. 250/- for each subsequent Programmes, through Online mode only.

Step-8:

Applicant can view the Application details by providing username and password. Applicant is required to make sure that "Application Status" on application form is "Fee Received" after 3 days otherwise application will be treated as incomplete and summarily rejected.

Step-9:

Candidates in their own interest are advised to apply & submit application promptly and not to wait till the last date/time for applying online. Directorate shall not be responsible if candidates are not able to submit their applications on account of the last-minute rush. Please retain print-out of application form for future references.

(IV) Admission Procedure for different Programmes

- (A) **General Courses:** The selection of a candidate shall be based on his/her performance in the Entrance Test. The Entrance Test shall carry weightage of 60 marks (for 2-year programmes) and 80 marks (60+20) (for 1-Year Programme) and a candidate shall be considered for selection if he/she has obtained positive score. However, there shall be a common question paper of 60 MCQs for both 2-year as well as 1-year PG programmes and a separate question paper of 20 MCQs for candidates who opt for 1-year PG Programme Further, where a programme is offered at more than one Campus/College, a candidate having given Campus/College preference shall only be considered; however, the same can be changed during counseling/mop-up round of selection.
- (B) **Biotechnology:** The admission of the candidates shall be made on the basis of valid GAT-B score.
- (C) **Social Work:** A candidate shall have to appear in the Entrance Test based on two papers (Paper I and II) on a single day. Question Paper I shall comprise 60 multiple choice questions [in a similar manner as in other subjects] carrying 60 marks as per the syllabus prescribed for the purpose. The Question Paper II shall comprise 4 questions carrying 60 marks on the topics specified in the prescribed syllabus. The candidates shall be required to attempt all the questions in 2½ hours.
- On the basis of their merit in Paper I, answer books of Paper II of the candidates numbering four times the intake capacity (both under open merit and reserved categories) shall be evaluated.



Final selection for admission to the programme shall be based on the combined merit obtained by the candidates in Paper I & II.

- (D) **Mass Communication & Journalism:** A candidate shall have to appear in the Entrance Test based on two papers (Paper I and II) on a single day. Question Paper I shall comprise 60 multiple choice questions [in a similar manner as in other subjects] carrying 60 marks as per the syllabus prescribed for the purpose.

The Question Paper II shall comprise 5 questions carrying 40 marks on broad topics specified in the prescribed syllabus. The candidates shall be required to attempt all the questions in 2 hours.

On the basis of their merit in Paper I, answer books of Paper II of the candidates numbering five times the intake capacity (both under open merit and reserved categories) shall be evaluated.

Final selection for admission to the programme shall be based on the combined merit obtained by the candidates in Paper I and Paper II.

- (E) **Nanotechnology:** There are 3 sections i.e. Section “A” Chemistry containing 32 questions from 8 Units compulsory for all candidates and 2 Sections of “B” & “C” optional (Biology & Physics) containing 28 questions from 7 Units, out of which only one section is to be attempted).
- (F) **Integrated MBA (BBA-MBA):** The admission to IMBA (BBA-MBA) 5-year programme shall be made on the basis of valid UGAT score. Candidates desirous to seek admission to IMBA (BBA-MBA) must have appeared in UGAT examination. In case UGAT applicants are less or the seats remain vacant, then Entrance Test shall be conducted by the University for filling up the vacant seats.
- (G) **MBA/MBA (Financial Studies)/MBA (CME):** The admission to MBA/MBA (Financial Studies)/MBA (CME) Programmes shall be made on the basis of valid CMAT score. Candidates desirous to seek admission to these Programmes must have appeared in CMAT examinations as already notified by the University. In case CMAT applicants are less or the seats remain vacant, then Entrance Test shall be conducted by the University for filling up the vacant seats.
- (H) **M.Tech. Programmes:** Candidates desirous to seek admission to M.Tech. Programme must have valid GATE Qualified score. In case GATE Qualified applicants are less or the seats remain vacant, then Entrance Test shall be conducted by the University for filling up the vacant seats.
- (I) **B. Tech. Programmes:** In case of B. Tech programmes, the admission shall be made on the basis of the latest JEE Mains (Best of two) score. In case seats remain vacant, the university shall conduct its own Entrance Test for filling up the vacant seats.
- (J) **M.Pharm:** The admission of the candidates shall be made on the basis of valid GPAT score. In case GPAT applicants are less or the seats remain vacant, then Entrance Test shall be conducted by the University for filling up the vacant seats.
- M. P. Ed.:** For M.P.Ed. Programme, only those applicants who qualify physical efficiency test shall be eligible to appear in the Entrance Test.
- (K) **M.Sc. Statistics:** There are 2 sections i.e. Section “A” Statistic containing 60 questions from 15 Units and Section of “B” Math for Statistics containing 60 questions from 15 Units, out of which only one section is to be attempted).
- (L) **5-Year Integrated B. Sc-M. Sc Physics/Energy Studies:** Syllabus for entrance test for these course shall be same. Therefore, admission to these two programmes shall be based on a single entrance paper; however the candidates have to exercise preference at the time of filling of online application form.
- (M) **M.Com:** There are 3 Sections based on three specialization, the candidates shall be required to attempt all question from a single section.



(V) Entry & Exit Options

1) Entry options for 5-year integrated Masters programmes

For 5-year integrated programmes, following entry options shall be available, subject to availability of vacancies:

- a) In **Seventh semester**, admission shall be granted to two-year Masters programme subject to availability of vacancies.
- b) In **Ninth semester**, admission shall be granted to one year Masters programme subject to availability of vacancies.

2) Exit options for 5-year integrated Masters programmes:

For 5-year integrated programmes, following exit options shall be available:

- a) After successfully completing three years (6 Semesters), candidates can exit with a **Bachelor's Degree** in the concerned subject
- b) After successfully completing four years (8 Semesters), candidates can exit with **Honors Degree** in the concerned subject
- c) After successfully completing five years (10 Semesters), the candidate shall get **Five Year Integrated Master's Degree**.

3) Masters programme

Candidates who seek admission for Masters programme shall have following options:

- a) **One-year Master's Degree:** Candidates joining Masters programme after four-year graduation shall get one year Master's degree
- b) **Two years Master's Degree:** Candidate who join 2-year Masters programme after successful completion 2 years shall get 2-year Master's degree in the concerned subject.
- c) **PG Diploma:** Candidates who join two years Masters Programme but exits after successfully completing one year shall get PG Diploma in the concerned subject.

(VI) Reservation of Seats for admission to different Programmes/Courses

Fifty percent (50%) of seats available in a Programme/Course of study shall be filled up from Open merit category candidates. Remaining fifty percent (50%) of seats available in a Programme/Course shall be filled up from amongst the reserved categories in order of merit. Supernumerary seats shall be in addition to intake capacity of a programme. The breakup of seats for various reserved categories and the authorities competent to issue the required certificate in respect of the reserved categories are given in Tables 13 & 14 below:

- (i) The benefit of admission under a Reserved Category/Supernumerary seat (Tables 13 & 14) shall be granted only once to a candidate for admission to any PG and UG Programmes separately; however, a subsequent benefit under SN category can be availed in case of non-availability of SN candidate in the general list.
- (ii) Differently-abled [not less than 40% permanent disability] {DA} category and Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) shall not be considered under OM even if having higher entrance test score {as they are put to a disadvantage on account of fee waiver and/or receiving Scholarship}.
- (iii) If a candidate is eligible to apply for admission under more than one reserved category, he/she shall be required to choose (while submitting the online Application Form) only one Reserved Category for one programme under which he/she would like to be considered, which shall be final, and unchangeable. For example, if a candidate is eligible under three categories RBA, CDP, and Sports, he/she shall have to choose only one of the



three categories under which he/she shall compete for admission to a particular programme. Say, if he/ she is an applicant for PG programmes in A, B, C and D subjects, he/she may compete in all the programmes but only under one of these three categories (RBA, CDP or Sports whichever he/she likes) or he/she may compete (say for instance) under RBA for A, under CDP for B, under Sports for C and under RBA for D. He/she is not, however, permitted to compete under more than one category for a single programme i.e., he/she cannot, for instance, apply under RBA as well as CDP for a single programme.

- (iv) Only candidates residing within the territorial jurisdiction of Kashmir Division and/or those who have passed their qualifying examination through Universities/Boards of Kashmir are eligible to seek admission under open merit as well as reserved categories (1-9) (Table 13), however, in case of courses/programmes not offered by Universities of Jammu Division, candidates residing in any part of the J&K are also eligible to apply under open and reserved categories (1-9) (Table 13).
- (v) The certificates under clauses 1-9 except that at Sr. No. 7, 8 & 9 in Table 13 must be in accordance with SRO 126 of 28th June 1994 of the J&K Government and subsequent SRO's issued by the Government time to time in this regard.
- (vi) Candidates residing outside the territorial jurisdiction of Kashmir Division (who have not passed their qualifying examination through Universities/Institutes/Boards of Kashmir Division) shall be eligible to apply under category OSJ (Sr. No. 3 Table 14) for all subjects/programmes, unless otherwise indicated/subject to determination of their eligibility/equivalence to the degree.
- (vii) One Supernumerary seat in each programme (irrespective of number of Campuses/Colleges) belonging to children of Permanent Employees (Serving/Retired) of the University of Kashmir (under Category 7) (Table 14), in order of merit provided he/she produces a Certificate from the Registrar, University of Kashmir. The eligibility for admission and the procedure of selection would be the same as prescribed for categories shown in Table-13 above.
- (viii) NRI/NRI Sponsored shall be considered under the Supernumerary category "5" (Table 14) and shall be governed by the admission policy reflected under Clause of the Prospectus "NRI/NRI Sponsored". The eligibility for admission and the procedure of selection would be the same as prescribed for categories shown in Table-13 above.
- (ix) Foreign students shall be considered under the Supernumerary category "6" (Table 14) and shall be governed by the admission policy reflected under Clause of the Prospectus "ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS".

(VIII) Entrance Examination:

- 1) The eligible candidates shall be required to appear in Entrance Test to be conducted by the University of Kashmir, there shall be a common question paper of 60 MCQs for both 2-year as well as 1-year PG programmes and a separate question paper of 20 MCQs for candidates who opt for 1-year PG Programme:

However, for programmes MA Social Work and MA Mass Communication & Journalism, there shall be descriptive paper also and for MTTM programme there are 120 multiple choice question (MCQ) carrying a total of hundred twenty marks as per the prescribed syllabus. The detailed syllabi (based on the syllabus prescribed for all the major courses of the 3-Year and 4-Year Undergraduate Programme of the concerned subject) and previous year's entrance papers of all PG and other programmes "to which University is offering admission" are available on the official website of the University (www.kashmiruniversity.net or www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in).

- 2) Entrance Test may not be conducted for admission to a programme/ course where intake capacity is equal to or more than the number of eligible applicants, in such cases the selection shall be made on the basis of academic percentage of the qualifying examination.
- 3) Negative marking shall be @ 25% per question i.e., for each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted.
- 4) In respect to the below mentioned Programmes, candidates must have a valid score in national level tests conducted by various agencies shown against each; however, if seats still remain vacant, Entrance test will be conducted immediately by the University for which separate notification will be issued.

(IX) Uploading of Answer Keys and Result of Entrance Test

The Answer Key of a subject shall be displayed on the University website immediately after the test is conducted. Complaints and queries, shall be received online at admissions@kashmiruniversity.ac.in from the examinees within one working day (upto 4:00 p.m.) from the date of uploading of keys/displaying of keys on the University website, which will be resolved by the Subject experts and revised key shall be uploaded subsequently. No complaints, whatsoever, shall be entertained thereafter and the result of the test/s shall be processed where each candidate shall get his/her Entrance Merit.

(X) Preparation and Declaration of Merit Lists

- (i) All the notifications/lists/forms etc. shall be uploaded only on the official website of the University and the candidates. In their own interest, are advised to visit the university website for all updates. All notifications uploaded on the university website shall be deemed to have been served to the candidates. The University does not own any responsibility for a candidate not being informed and no candidate shall be informed separately.
- (ii) All those candidates, who had applied provisionally, shall ensure that they fulfill their eligibility conditions latest by **18th May 2026 (for Courses/Programmes based on 12th qualification)** and **28th July 2026 (for Programmes based on Graduation)**, failing which their name shall not figure in the **Merit Lists**, even if having appeared in the Entrance Test. They shall be personally responsible for any kind of delay in producing the required final qualifying certificate and consequences thereof.
- (iii) The detailed merit lists mentioning entrance points, details of the qualifying examination and other components, as per the procedure of admission for various Programmes, shall be displayed on the University website. Complaints and queries (if any), shall be received by the Directorate of Admissions & Competitive Examinations, only through e-mail at admissions@kashmiruniversity.ac.in, with documentary proofs. The complaints and queries shall be received and attended by the Directorate for one day (upto 4:00 p.m.) from the date of uploading of merit list on university website. Thereafter, the Selection Lists shall be issued. No complaints, whatsoever, shall be entertained with respect to eligibility or individual merit of a candidate after publishing of the selection list.

(XI) Preparation and Declaration of Selection List

(A) Preparation of Selection Lists: The following procedure shall be adopted to prepare selection list:

- (i) As per the intake, seat matrix indicating number of seats and fraction of a seat from each category shall be prepared separately for 2-year programmes and 1-year programmes.
- (ii) Wherein, %age of category/ies does not make a full seat, the fractions of such categories (fractions) shall be clubbed together for seat allocation. Seat allocation shall be done as per **interse merit** within clubbed/unrepresented categories, subject to the condition that not more than one seat shall be allotted to a category the fractional part of which was clubbed up. In case number of seats is more than one, the next seat shall be given to an unrepresented category within fractions as per higher merit.
- (iii) Horizontal reserved categories (CDP-1, CDP-2 and SPORTS) each have 1% reservation which doesn't make a full seat in majority of the programmes/courses. As such the three categories shall be clubbed together and the seat shall be allotted as per merit; however, minimum of



one seat shall be given to these clubbed categories. Further, being horizontal reservation, if any candidate among these three categories figures in the Open Merit, no further seat shall be allotted to any of these three horizontal reserved categories.

- (iv) In case, no eligible candidate is available under a particular reserved category, the seat(s) including fractional part under that category shall be shifted to open merit category excluding Supernumerary seats.
- (v) In case, the number of eligible candidates available under a particular reserved category is not sufficient, the remaining seat(s) including fractional part under that category shall be shifted to open merit category excluding Supernumerary seats.
- (vi) All seats available under the open merit category except any fractional part shall be allotted to eligible candidates in order of their merit irrespective of their applied categories *i.e.*, if a reserved category candidate of **Table 13** figures in merit list, he/she shall be shifted to open merit in the 1st instance except for EWS, DA, OSJ & FN/NRI.
- (vii) All seats except fractional part available under the reserved category/ies shall be allotted to eligible candidates in order of merit leaving behind fractional part.
- (viii) Fractional parts attached to all categories including open merit category (but excluding Supernumerary seats) left shall be clubbed together (added) to calculate resultant seat/s to be allotted under open merit as well as reserved category/ies whose fraction was added; however, preference shall be given to such category/ies which have not been represented in step (vii) above and thereafter any resultant vacancy shall be given to open merit / reserved categories whose fractional part was added up on the basis of merit. Needless to mention that maximum of one seat through this exercise shall be allotted on the basis of merit to the Open Merit/Reserved category/ies whose fractional part was added.
- (ix) If at any stage no eligible candidate is available for admission from a reserved category, that seat/fractional part shall be shifted to open merit category and filled up.

(B) Declaration of Selection Lists: The following procedure shall be adopted for declaring selection list:

- (i) **The first selection lists** for all programmes/courses of the main Campus shall be issued on the basis of relative merit and preferences given by the candidates in the Application Form.
- (ii) Notification for inviting application forms for **self-finance seat quota** shall be issued along-with the 1st selection list and the candidates on the basis of their merit shall apply for self-finance Seats. Please note that admission against self finance seats shall be made solely on the basis of Merit.
- (iii) Notification for inviting application forms for **NRI/NRI sponsored quota** shall also be issued along-with the 1st selection list and the candidates shall apply for NRI/NRI sponsored quota. Please note that admission against self finance seats shall be made on the basis of Merit of qualifying examination.
- (iv) Immediately after the last date of 1st selection list, (a) admission for left over vacant seats of 1st selection list for main campus, (b) selection list against self-finance seats of main campus, (c) selection list against NRI/NRI sponsored seats of main campus, (d) 1st selection list for offsite campuses, (e) self finance seat list of the offsite campuses and (f) NRI/NRI sponsored lists of the off-site campuses shall be issued simultaneously.



- (v) Please note that if a candidate is provisionally selected and fails to complete admission formalities, he/she shall forfeit right to admission in subsequent lists till candidates are available.
- (vi) In case vacancies are available / are caused even after issuance of two selection lists, admission against vacant seats shall be made on the basis of **online counseling**. The counseling to a programme/course where the seats remain vacant after the issuance of two selection lists, shall be meant for only those candidates who are in waiting list *e.g.*, if the cut off merit of 2nd selection list was 20 points, the counseling should be only for the candidates having obtained 19.75 points and below; however, the candidate already selected in main selection lists and has forfeited his/her right to admission due to non-completion of admission formalities, shall be given a chance for appearing in the counseling only after the candidates in the merit list have been exhausted in full. Therefore, students in their own interest shall remain in touch with the website of the Directorate of Admissions & Competitive Examinations where all updates shall be available.
- (vii) While issuing the Counseling Notification on the University website, seat matrix in various categories across various Campuses/ Colleges shall also be made available and the candidates shall have the option to give fresh Option on Counseling Form available on the University website while submitting the online counseling forms.
- (viii) If a candidate gets selected in more than one programme/s he/she shall have to give on-spot consent for one programme only which shall be treated as final and no change shall be entertained thereafter.
- (ix) **Important Note for Candidates attending Counseling:** Selection list against available vacancies and waiting list shall be drawn on the basis of counseling in order of merit. Since all the processes (except verification of certificates by the respective Departments) including deposition of Fee is online, **provisionally selected candidates shall be given three days to complete admission formalities**, failing which next candidate in the waiting list shall be granted admission. Therefore, candidates in the waiting list, in their own interest, are advised to remain in touch with the concerned Department to find admission prospects.
- (x) After formally closure of admission, no shifting shall be granted under any circumstances.

(XII) Resolution of Tie

Where two or more candidates have secured equal marks in the entrance test for admission to a particular programme, the tie shall be decided as under:

- a) On the basis of aggregate merit obtained in the qualifying examination, *i.e.*, a candidate with higher aggregate marks shall be given preference;
- b) If the tie still persists, the aggregate merit of the subject in which the admission is sought shall be reckoned by taking the merit of that subject in all the years (3 years or 4 years) of the qualifying examination into account;
- c) In case the problem still remains unresolved or the candidate seeks admission to a Programme where the discipline in which he/she seeks admission is not taught at undergraduate level, then candidate with higher academic merit in the preceding examination *i.e.*, merit in Hr. Sec. Part-II (10+2) where the minimum qualification is graduation and merit in Matric where the minimum qualification for admission is 10+2 shall be given preference.
- d) If still tie persists then candidate older in age shall be given preference.



(XIII) Shifting From Reserved Category To Open Merit Quota

A candidate seeking admission under a particular Reserved Category (except EWS, DA, OSJ, or FN/NRI) shall at first instance be automatically shifted to the Open Merit Category, (if otherwise eligible), if the total points scored entitle him/her to figure in the open merit list. However, once admission granted, the candidate cannot be shifted to Open Merit in subsequent lists at the same Campus/College.

(XIV) Admission Under Self-Financed Seats Category

Application under Self-financed seats quota can be made for admission to all programmes/courses against 30% quota of the approved intake capacity of a particular Programme/Course separately for 2-year as well as 1-year programme/course. The notification for admission under Self-financed seats shall be issued immediately after issuance of 1st selection list and only those candidates who have appeared in the Entrance Test and apply for admission under Self Financed Category on the prescribed format available on the official website of the University shall be considered for admission under this category. However, in Programmes where the number of applicants is less, admission can be granted on the basis of qualifying examination merit. The selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of merit (among the applicants for this category of seats) which shall be the same as prescribed for selection of candidates against open seats. The candidates selected against Self-financed seats shall be required to pay normal fee as chargeable to other candidates, in addition to the fee charged under self-financed seats. The fee for self-financed seats shall be non-refundable payable in three installments (50% at the time of joining Semester 1 and 25% each at the time of joining semesters 3rd & 4th). If a candidate leaves a seat/quits a course after closing of admission and the seat remains vacant, the fee shall not be refunded/ transferred, even if the same candidate is selected for some other course within the University. In case of IMBA, the self- financed seat fee shall have to be deposited in four equal installments at the time of admission to 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th semesters. The normal fee in both the cases has to be deposited at the time of the admission.

(XV) Shifting from Self-Financed Seat Quota to Open Category Quota

A candidate selected under Self-finance seat quota shall remain personally in touch with the concerned Department/Directorate of Admissions & Competitive Examinations for seeking admission prospects against the available vacant seat, if any, under Open Merit/Reserved Category only, if the total marks scored him/her figure in the selection list. However, after formally closure of admission, no shifting shall be granted under any circumstances even if seats get vacant on account of cancelling of admission for whatsoever reasons in Open Merit or Reserved Categories.

(XVI) Admission of NRI/NRI Sponsored Candidates

- a) **Seat allocation:** Application under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota can be made for admission to all programmes/courses against 10% quota of the intake capacity of a particular Programme/Course. These seats shall be over and above the intake.
- b) **Categories of NRI:** The University shall fill the 10% quota of NRI/NRI Sponsored candidates originally belongs to the UT of J&K in the following manner:



- i. **Category 1:** Preference shall be given to the NRI or blood relations of the NRI's *i.e.*, son/daughter/real brother/real sister of NRIs for admission against available vacancies. The NRI's MUST submit an NRI certificate obtained from Indian Diplomatic Mission/Chancellery/High Commission under their seal; whereas blood relations MUST submit sufficient documents (family tree attested by Tehsildar concerned) clarifying without ambiguity their true relationship with the NRI to the satisfaction of the University.
 - ii. **Category 2:** If seats remain vacant, candidates sponsored by an NRI shall be granted admission against vacancies. The candidate MUST submit the documents as annexed to these instructions as per instructions.
- c) **Academic Eligibility:** Marks Eligibility for admission under NRI shall be the same as that for Open Merit candidates *i.e.*, marks %age of the qualifying examination shall be the same as that for General category without any consideration of the reserved category. The candidates should have passed the qualifying examination in full without any backlogs.
- d) **Subject Eligibility:** Subject combination eligibility of the candidates regarding qualifying examination for a programme shall be the same as for general candidates.
- e) **Documents Required for NRI Candidate:**

Where an applicant himself /herself is NRI or the applicant is a blood relation of the NRI, and family originally belongs to the UT of J&K.)

- (i) Qualifying Examination Marks Card;
- (ii) NRI certificate issued by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India or Indian Embassy Overseas under Ministry of External Affairs with holding of Indian Passport or Pedigree Table/Family Tree establishing relationship of the candidate with the NRI along with documentary Proof (Blood relations of NRI);
- (iii) Pedigree Table/Family Tree establishing relationship of the candidate with the NRI along with documentary Proof (for blood relations of NRI only);
- (iv) NRI Bank Account preferably in the country where the candidate is residing or of NRI Account in India;
- (v) Copy of Indian Passport;
- (vi) PAN Card, and
- (vii) Domicile Certificate of the candidate
- (viii) Affidavit as per prescribed format (Annexure-A)

Documents Required for NRI Sponsored Candidates:

- (i) Qualifying Examination Marks Card;



- (ii) NRI Sponsorship Letter (Annexure-B);
- (iii) Undertaking of NRI duly attested by the legal authority of that country where sponsor is residing or Indian Embassy Overseas;
- (iv) Bank Statement of the Sponsor;
- (v) Resident/National Certificate or NRI certificate of the sponsor;
- (vi) Employment certificate of the sponsor;
- (vii) PAN Card of the sponsor;
- (viii) Domicile of the candidate.
- (ix) Affidavit as per prescribed format (Annexure-A)

Candidates seeking admission in more than one programme/course under NRI quota must fill separate application forms for each programme/course.

(XVII) Admission of Foreign Students

- 1) The number of seats for admission under the category shall be 5% of total intake capacity fixed for the Programme and shall be over and above the existing intake capacity. The admission under the category shall be open for the following categories of students. However, in case a given Department is willing to admit more foreign students in view of its adequate accommodation and infrastructural facilities. The number of seats can be increased by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the Departmental Committee.

General Category:

The Foreign National shall not be required to appear in the entrance test. They shall apply on the prescribed format for admission as and when admission notification is issued by the University;

a) Cultural Exchange Programme:

The students seeking admission under the Cultural Exchange Programme of Government of India shall be required to approach the Indian Council of Cultural Relations, Azad Bhavan, IP State, New Delhi-110001, India. In the event of their selection, the Council will be informed about their selection.

- b) The foreign students shall be required to fulfill the required eligibility conditions for obtaining admission to different courses.



- c) In case, the number of applications is more than the seats available in a programme, the admission of students shall be granted on the basis of merit in the qualifying examinations;
- d) Foreign nationals admitted to the Programme shall be required to get medical insurance cover and the same shall be mandatory for all such foreign students;
- e) The foreign nationals admitted under this category shall be required to get clearance from all the relevant agencies of the Government of J&K and Govt. of India;
- f) Other terms and conditions of admission shall be same as are in vogue for admission under other categories of admission.

(XVIII) Admission at Satellite Campuses and Colleges

For admission to programmes which are also offered in Satellite Campuses of the University or Colleges affiliated to the University of Kashmir, the procedure of selection shall be the same as described earlier, with the provision that a candidate shall have to indicate in clear terms his/her order of preference for the campuses/ colleges, where the course is offered in the space provided for the purpose in the Application Form and in the Counseling Form as the case may be. For example, if a post-graduate programme (say PG in subject X) is offered at three places, Campus A, Campus B and College I, the applicant may give his/her order of preference in any one of the following ways:

Candidates must note that shifting/ migration from campuses to University or from one teaching Department/Centre/Institute/Campus/College to another (even on mutual basis) is not provided under rules. No recommendation from any Department/Centre/Institute/ Campus/ College in this regard shall be entertained. The preference indicated by a candidate during submission of online Application Form shall be treated as final and in the event a candidate fails to mention preference, he/she will not be considered for admission in 1st and 2nd selection lists. These candidates shall be considered only during counseling session.

(XIX) Procedure for completing admission formalities

The provisionally selected candidates shall have to complete the admission by or before the last date fixed for the purpose by following the below mentioned steps:

1. **Eligibility:**

Since admission is granted provisionally, the candidates in their own interest shall check the eligibility, well in advance.

2. **Admission Form:**

They shall download their online Admission Form from official website of the University of Kashmir www.kashmiruniversity.net by entering their Entrance Test Roll No./Application Form No.

3. **Credentials:**

They shall approach the concerned Department alongwith all the below mentioned documents (Original and set of self attested xerox copies):

- Marks Card/s of qualifying examination;
- Domicile certificate;
- Character Certificate, Provisional Certificate of the Institution last attended (if applicable))
- Affidavit
- Migration certificate (for those students who haven't passed the immediate previous examination through University of Kashmir));

4. **Dual Degree:**

Candidates can pursue two academic programmes simultaneously i.e. one regular and the other through Distance/Open/Online Mode in accordance with the UGC regulations dated 13 April, 2022.

5. **Affidavit:**

The provisionally selected candidate shall prepare an affidavit sworn in before 1st Class Judicial Magistrate stating that:

- I fulfill all the eligibility conditions as laid down for the programme in _____;
- I am not pursuing any similar course through Regular/Distance/Open/Online Mode;
- All the information submitted including certificates and documents are genuine;
- I understand that in case of any misinformation or concealment of any information or indiscipline, my admission to the programme shall be cancelled and I shall be subjected to legal action;
- I shall strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the University in toto;

6. **Fee deposition:**

After verifying the documents at the Department concerned, please ensure that they have **accepted online** your Admission Form and then deposit the requisite admission fee through online mode only;

7. **Submission of Hard Copy:**

After depositing the requisite fee online, the candidate has to submit the hard copy of the Admission Form alongwith all the documents, certificates, affidavit and fee receipt in the concerned Department/Centre/Institute/College against proper receipt. Further correspondence is to be made with the concerned Department only.

8. **Registration:**

Candidates joining University of Kashmir have to get registered with the University of Kashmir for which they shall contact the concerned Departments; however, this doesn't apply to Graduates of University of Kashmir.



f) Closure of Admission

The date for Closure of Admission shall be notified well in advance in the “Admission calendar” to provide sufficient time to all concerned to fill up all the available seats. In the event seats remaining vacant, the concerned officials shall be responsible and shall have to submit in writing to Director, Directorate of Admissions & Competitive Examinations the reasons for the same, which shall be communicated to the authorities for perusal.

g) Refund of Fee

(as per UGC fee refund policy 2024-25) vide order No. F.2-71/2022(CPP-II) (C-11453=46) dated 12th June, 2024

If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he/she is enrolled, the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student shall be followed:

Sr. No.	% of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
5	No Refund	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission



Section IV – General Instructions

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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO ASPIRING CANDIDATES

Candidates interested in seeking admission at University of Kashmir are instructed to:

1. Regularly visit the official website of the university viz., www.kashmiruniversity.net or www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in for all notifications, updates, merit lists, selection lists, counseling forms etc. The University does not publish such information through any other medium/agency other than displaying it on the official University website and only such official website notifications shall be treated as authentic for all purposes.
2. Check the tentative dates given for various admissions related activities so that you don't miss any opportunity.
3. Check the eligibility for admissions to various programmes/courses with reference to the Admission Prospectus available on the University website. University offers Programmes/Courses for +2 level (Class 12th) as well as for Graduates and Post-Graduates. All the details are available in the Admission Prospectus;
4. Read the reservation roster available in the prospectus thoroughly and apply accordingly. Please note that in case of furnishing of any incomplete or wrong/ambiguous information, misrepresentation of facts, the candidate shall be personally responsible for all the legal consequences.
5. Fill in the online application form as per instructions with precision, as the details furnished are taken as authentic and no verification takes place till a candidate submits original documents at the time of admission in the concerned department/centre/institute. If any discrepancies/fraudulent entries/documents are noted at any time, the provisional admission shall be summarily cancelled without any further notice.
6. Check the examination Date Sheet only on the University website and prepare accordingly.
7. Check Roll Number and Centre allotted with the General Centre Notice, available only on the University Website well before the commencement of the Entrance Test.
8. Download the Admit Card at least 2 days ahead of the Entrance Test from the official website of the University and report for any discrepancies before Entrance Test. No queries shall be received after the Entrance Test is over.
9. Carefully read all instructions provided on the Admit Card including the centre location, date and time.
10. Carry valid original Government issued photo identity card (Adhaar, Passport, Election etc.) and downloaded admit card. Note that without Admit Card and Identity Card, examinees won't be allowed to enter the examination hall.



11. Reach the test center at least one hour before the scheduled test time and ensure to locate the centre and seat allotted on the seating plan pasted outside the examination centre.
12. Enter the examination hall/room at least 30 minutes before the start of the examination, but not less than 15 minutes before start of the test. No late coming shall be allowed, as the gates of the examination halls are closed at the start of the examination time, and the candidates shall be personally responsible for any consequences due to late arrival.
13. Avoid carrying any unauthorized/prohibited material (*e.g.*, written notes, paper, eraser, writing pad, wallet, pouch etc.) and don't carry any electronic and communication gadgets like mobile phone, tablet, watch, ear pods, etc. Please note that there shall not be any arrangements for keeping these items/gadgets in the examination hall, and the candidates have to leave them outside the examination hall, on their own risk and responsibility.
14. Strictly abstain from wearing face masks and carrying any metallic item including belts, bracelet, ear rings, rings, chains, jewelry item, etc.
15. Avoid wearing boots rather wear chappals, slippers, sandals with low heels.
16. Avoid carrying any eatables in the examination hall; however, transparent water bottles only are allowed.
17. Occupy the allotted seat and don't change the allotted seat which will invite framing of an unfair case, may consequentially lead to cancellation of the candidature and/or answer sheet.
18. Place the Admit Card and valid ID card on the desk throughout the examination.
19. Comply with the instructions of invigilators at all times *e.g.*, start of test, breaking of seal of Question Booklet, end of test, handing over of original OMR Answer Sheet etc.
20. Desist from any kind of copying including side talks/any misconduct/sharing of information which may lead to cancellation of candidature, penalty and punishment.
21. Restrain from sharing any other materials or communicate with or seek help from other candidates during the test.
22. Read the instructions thoroughly on the OMR sheet and fill in the relevant particulars. The OMR shall be provided 10 minutes before start of the examination for reading the instruction and for filling the relevant details.
23. Read the instructions thoroughly on the Question Booklet and fill in the Booklet Number and Series on the OMR Sheet. The Question Booklet shall be provided 5 minutes before the commencement of the test, but don't open the seal before start of the test, as this may lead to unfair act.



24. Make sure that you have completely and correctly, written your Roll No. and other required details on the OMR sheets as well as on the cover page of the Question Booklet.
25. Check the OMR thoroughly 5 minutes before concluding of the test. Fold the top strip along the perforation and tear off the strip at the perforation line on the top of the OMR Sheet to separate duplicate copy from the original OMR Sheet without damaging edges of the OMR Sheet.
26. **Remember that there will be negative marking for this test @ 25% i.e., for every wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted.**
27. **Be informed that admission shall be granted only on getting positive entrance test score.**
28. Disperse after examination is over and leave the examination centre immediately.
29. Visit only the official website of University of Kashmir www.kashmiruniversity.net or www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in on which the **answer keys shall be uploaded** on the same day after the examination is over. Queries regarding entrance questions or answer key (if any) with documentary evidence shall be received via e-mail at admissions@kashmiruniversity.ac.in within 24 hours from the date of uploading of the answer key. These queries shall be referred to an expert committee and if need arises, modified answer key shall be uploaded, after which no further query shall be entertained and the result shall be processed.
30. Ensure that **candidates have uploaded all the eligibility documents before the last date fixed for the purpose**, failing which the Roll No./Name of the candidate shall not figure in the merit list, which automatically means that such candidates shall not be considered for admission even if having higher merit. Consequences, whatsoever, shall be the responsibility of the candidates.
31. Note that the selection lists shall be uploaded on the University website only as per the notified schedule and candidates are expected to strictly follow all dates as mentioned on admission schedule in letter and spirit. Please note that **no extensions shall be granted** and any candidate failing to complete admission formalities within prescribed/notified time period **shall forfeit admission and shall not be given a second chance till all candidates in the merit list get exhausted**;
32. Contact the Head/Coordinator of the respective Department/Programme (whose details are given on the website) for any admission related queries;
33. Finally note that the information/notices/entrance schedules/selection lists etc. displayed on the University of Kashmir official website shall only be treated as authentic for all purposes.

6. Question Booklet is provided 5 minutes ahead of the actual start of the examination to allow examinees to read the instructions, fill in the information on the Question Booklet and fill in the relevant information of the Question Booklet on the OMR Answer Sheet.
7. The Question Booklet remains sealed and the seal is to be opened only when instructed by the Invigilation Staff at the time of actual start of the test.



8. All entries in the OMR Answer Sheet, including answers to questions, are to be recorded in the Original Copy only.
9. Fill up the necessary information in English in the spaces provided on OMR Answer Sheet including Question Booklet Number and Question Booklet Series (Not mentioning or writing wrong series may cause incorrect scoring & the University shall not be responsible for any consequences).
10. Choose the correct/most appropriate response for each question among the options A, B, C and D and darken the circle of the appropriate response completely. An incompletely darkened circle is not correctly read by the OMR Scanner and no complaint to this effect shall be entertained.
11. **Use only blue/black ball point pen to darken the circle of correct/most appropriate response. In no case gel/ink pen or pencil should be used.**
12. Do not darken more than one circle of options for any question. A question with more than one darkened response shall be considered wrong.
