





UNIVERSITY OF KASHMIR

The University of Jammu and Kashmir was founded in the year 1948. In the year 1969, it was bifurcated into two full-fledged Universities: University of Kashmir at Srinagar and University of Jammu at Jammu. The University of Kashmir is situated at Hazratbal in Srinagar. It is flanked by the world famous Dal Lake on its eastern side and Nigeen Lake on the western side. The main campus of the University, spread over 247 acres of land, is divided into three parts — Hazratbal Campus, Naseem Bagh Campus and Mirza Bagh Campus (serving residential purpose), with Zakura Campus situated near the main campus for further expansion of the University. The tranquil ambience of the campus provides the right kind of atmosphere for serious study and research.

Over the years, University of Kashmir has expanded substantially. It has established Satellite Campuses at Anantnag (South Campus), Baramulla (North Campus) and Kupwara (Kupwara Campus) to make higher education more accessible to people living in the remote areas of Kashmir valley. The University has also established a sub-office at Jammu to cater to the needs of the candidates enrolled with the University from outside Kashmir.

The University is committed to provide an intellectually stimulating environment for productive learning to enhance the educational, economic, scientific, business and cultural environment of the region. The University offers programmes in all the major faculties; Arts, Business & Management Studies, Education, Law, Applied Sciences & Technology, Biological Sciences, Physical & Material Sciences, Social Sciences, Medicine, Dentistry, Engineering, Oriental Learning and Music & Fine Arts. It has been constantly introducing innovative and new programmes to cater to the needs and demands of the students and the society.

Over the years, the University has marched towards excellence in its programmes and activities. It has been re-accredited as Grade-A⁺ University by the National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) of India. This is recognition and reflection of the high standard of quality in teaching and research at the University of Kashmir.









DEPARTMENT OF LINGUISTICS

Established in the year 1991, the Department of Linguistics, University of Kashmir, Srinagar has come a long way in establishing itself as one of the leading teaching and research departments, not only in the University of Kashmir but also at the national and international levels. The Department started offering Masters Programme in Linguistics from the year 1996, and Research programme from 2001. A comprehensive range of courses in theoretical, applied and interdisciplinary areas are provided by the department. The department reviews and updates its courses from time to time, keeping in view the evolving scenario of linguistics and needs of the students. Being the only department of its kind in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the department has accepted the mandate and the moral responsibility to carry out teaching and research activities on local languages, thereby serving the UT and its people in best possible way. In this regard, the department has served as the nodal centre for the Scheme for Preservation and Protection of Endangered Languages (SPPEL), undertaken by CIIL, Mysuru. Many major and minor projects, funded by different agencies like ICSSR, New Delhi, UGC New Delhi, NCPUL New Delhi, Sahitya Academy New Delhi, Jammu and Kashmir Academy of Art, Culture and Languages, Srinagar, Department of Electronics and Information Technology, Ministry of Communication and Information Technology, Government of India, South Asian Language Resource Centre, University of Chicago, Illinois, National Foreign Centre, University of Maryland, USA, etc., have also been undertaken by the department. The Department also publishes Interdisciplinary Journal of Linguistics (IJL), a refereed and peer reviewed annual journal, with ISSN number 0974-3421. Sixteen Volumes of the journal have been brought out since 2008.
