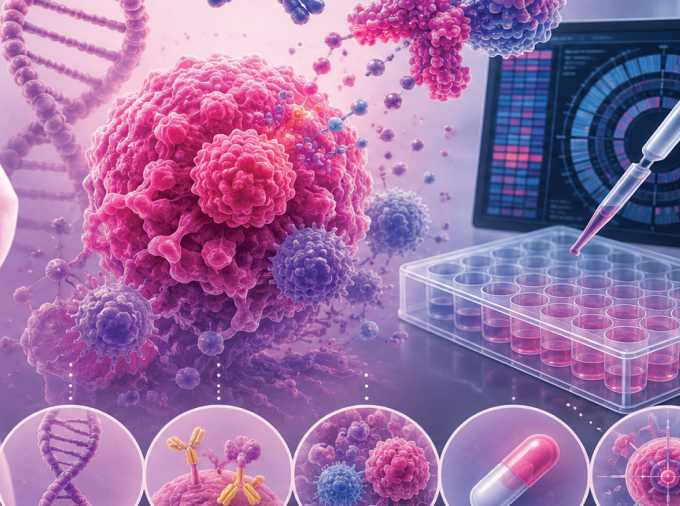

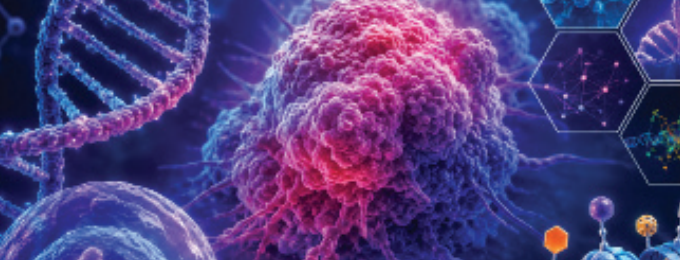

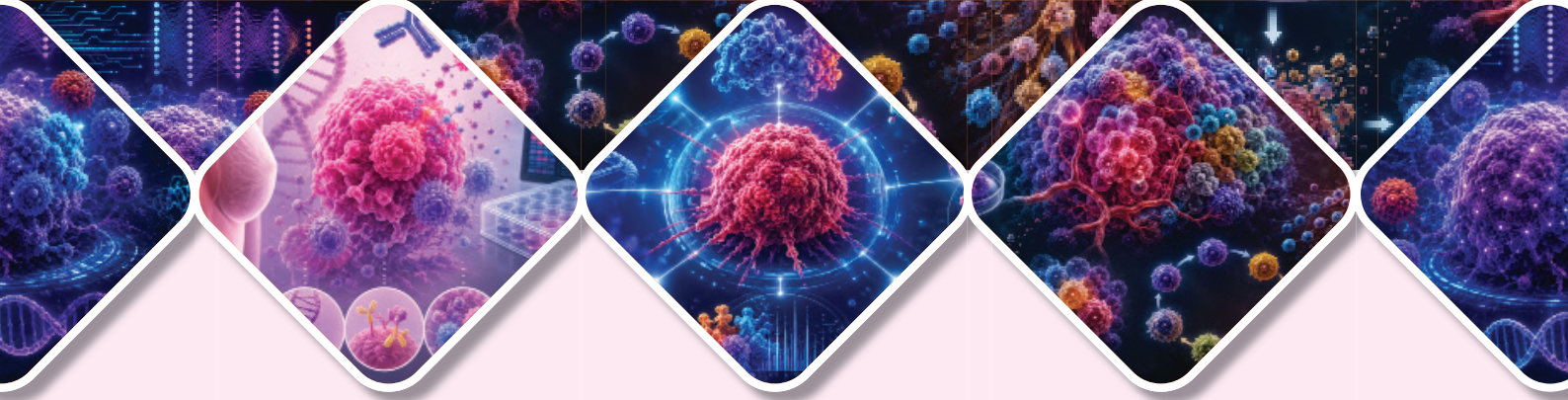
ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

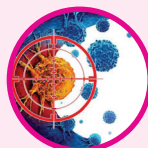

THRUST AREAS OF THE CONFERENCE

The scientific programme of 3rd Jammu & Kashmir International Conference on Breast and Allied Cancers (JK-IBAC 2026) will focus on emerging advances across the continuum of cancer research, diagnosis, treatment, and public health. Major thrust areas include:



Breast Cancer Biology and Precision

Oncology: Exploring the molecular mechanisms underlying breast cancer initiation, progression, and metastasis, with emphasis on precision diagnostics, biomarker discovery, and individualized therapeutic strategies.



Drug Discovery, Drug Repurposing and

Translational Therapeutics: Innovative approaches to identifying novel anticancer agents, repurposing existing drugs, and translating laboratory discoveries into clinically relevant therapies.



Molecular Oncology, Cancer Genomics

and Epigenomics: Recent advances in cancer genetics, genomic profiling, epigenetic regulation, and molecular alterations that influence tumor behavior, prognosis, and therapeutic response.



Nanotechnology and Advanced Drug

Delivery Systems: Emerging nanomaterials and smart drug delivery platforms designed to improve therapeutic efficacy, reduce toxicity, and enable targeted cancer treatment.



Multi-Omics Approaches in Cancer

Research: Integration of genomics, transcriptomics, proteomics, metabolomics, and single-cell technologies to understand cancer complexity and identify novel therapeutic targets.



Clinical Oncology, Surgical Oncology

and Radiation Oncology: Contemporary developments in multidisciplinary cancer management, including advances in surgery, radiation therapy, systemic therapies, and clinical trials.



Cancer Stem Cells, Therapeutic Resistance, Tumor Evolution, Heterogeneity and

Cellular Plasticity: Understanding the biological basis of tumor evolution, intratumoral heterogeneity, cancer stem cells, and mechanisms driving drug resistance to develop more effective treatment strategies.



Lifestyle, Nutrition and Environmental

Risk Factors in Cancer: The influence of diet, physical activity, environmental exposures, occupational hazards, and lifestyle factors on cancer prevention, risk assessment, and disease progression.



Immunotherapy, Targeted Therapy

and Personalized Medicine: Advances in immune-based therapies, molecularly targeted treatments, precision medicine, and predictive biomarkers for improving clinical outcomes.



Palliative Care, Survivorship and Quality

of Life: Strategies to enhance supportive care, symptom management, rehabilitation, survivorship, psychosocial well-being, and quality of life for cancer patients and survivors.



Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Digital Pathology in Oncology, Computational Biology, Bioinformatics and

Systems Oncology: Application of advanced computational tools and artificial intelligence in cancer diagnosis, prognosis, drug discovery, digital pathology, and integrative data analysis.



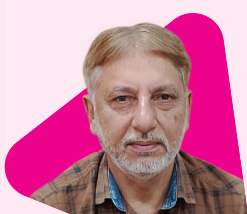
One Health Approaches in Cancer
