**Aspirants who have already cleared the UPSC Preliminary Examination in 2025, or those who qualify the UPSC Prelims scheduled for May 2026, are eligible for direct admission. They are exempted from the entrance test but must have submitted the application form to secure their seat.*

Additional Information:

1. Key Facilities and Support

- Comprehensive test series for Prelims (GS & CSAT), Mains (GS and Essay), and Optionals.
- Mentoring support by experienced domain experts to guide students throughout their preparation journey.
- Separate hostel for boys and girls in the vicinity of CCCP.
- Well-equipped, air-conditioned study spaces and discussion rooms.
- Free high-speed internet access is available round-the-clock to support digital learning and research.
- A capacious 2-storey building dedicated to CRISP.
- Available seats: 90, depending upon the availability of space in hostels.
- Daily access to national, local newspapers, monthly, fortnightly and other magazines.

2. Entrance Test Details

- The syllabus for the entrance test components is the same as UPSC CSE 2026, as available on the UPSC website.
- Two papers GS (including 20 CSAT questions and Essay) will be covered in two sessions as mentioned above.
- There will be negative marking for GS (1/3 of the weightage of each question will be deducted for each wrong answer).
- The top 500 students based on GS performance will have their essays evaluated

- Based upon the test performance, thrice the available intake student capacity of
- CCCP will be called upon for the Personality Test.
- The entrance will be conducted at the main and Jammu satellite campus of the University of Kashmir.
- The test will be conducted in the English language only
- Selection will be based solely on the cumulative merit achieved in the written test and interview.
- The application fee is Rs 300.
- **The Centre notification for the entrance test will be issued separately.**

3. Entrance Session Details and Marks Breakup

- Session 1: General Studies (GS): 100 MCQs (2 marks each), including 20 CSAT
- Session 2:
 - Essay: 50 marks (Essay to be written on any of the given 4 topics, with a word limit of 1200 words).
- Marks for Entrance Test: 250 (GS + Essay)
- Interview Marks: 50
- Total Marks: 300

4. Direct Admission

- **Current CCCP and non-CCCP students shall be exempted from the CCCP entrance test** and may be considered for **direct admission**, subject to submission of the admission form and fulfilment of the following criteria:
 - Must have **qualified UPSC CSE Prelims 2026** or **already qualified UPSC CSE Prelims 2025**; or
 - Must have **missed the JKAS (JKPSC) final selection by up to 5 marks** in their respective category in the latest available result.
- **Preference:** Priority shall be given to **test-exempt candidates**, and the **remaining seats will be filled through the entrance test.**
